The 26 year old is a heroin addict in withdrawal His signs and symptoms all indicate opiate withdrawal He has a runny nose, stomach cramps, dilated pupils, muscle spasms, chills, despite the warm weather, elevated heart rate and blood pressure, and is running a slight temperature He may or may not have other drug issues
