SUGGESTED SPRAY SCHEDULE FOR HOME GARDEN APPLES

Treat "stung" apples as source of codling moth by removing infested apples from the tree, seal in black garbage bags Leave in sun for two weeks to kill worms PRIMARY PEST OF APPLES Start preventative spraying of fruit 17-21 days after full bloom or 10 days after petal fall SPRAY TIMING IS CRITICAL -

Apples: Too Good To Waste Store: Store up to 7 days on the counter Refrigerate up to 3 weeks in an open plastic or paper bag to maintain moisture Use lemon juice to keep sliced apples from turning brown Freeze cooked or fresh apples (washed, peeled, sliced) coated in diluted lemon juice for up to 12 months in an airtight container Cook:
